


Tips for writing a well-structured, logical archaeological reports

(delicious hamburgers)



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
Use well-structured paragraphs to create logical reports

NOTE: this same structure is almost guaranteed to get you an "A" on college papers too.

Intro Sentence

Basic anatomy of a well-crafted sentence

The project area is in the Sonoran desertscrub lifezone.



Subject:

- Who is doing the action
- The doer

Predicate:

- What is being done
- Usually a verb

Object:

- What the sentence is about

Body

Plants located in this zone include saguaro, mesquite, ironwood, and cottonwood along washes.

Subject: Predicate:


“Plants” “located”

Object:

“in this zone include...”

Conclusion

Desertscrub plants are unique because they have evolved to survive with little rainfall.

Predicate

Object

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Paragraphs are built using well-crafted sentences that have a **Subject, Predicate, and Object**


Build each paragraph like a hamburger

Two buns + toppings = delicious hamburger

Intro sentence + Support sentences + conclusion sentence = well-structured paragraph

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What are you going to tell me about?
What is this thought about?

First support sentence

Second support sentence

Third to sixth support sentence


Show me you are at the end of this
thought

Build each report section like a hamburger

Intro paragraph + Support paragraphs + conclusion paragraph = logical essay

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Intro

What is your paragraph about?

Ex. The plants of the Sonoran desert scrub lifezone.



Supporting paragraph 1

First support paragraph

Ex. To what climate are these plants adapted?



Supporting paragraph 2

Second support paragraph

Ex. What are the overstory plants?



Supporting paragraph 3

Third support paragraph

Ex. What are the understory plants?



Supporting paragraph 4

Fourth support paragraph

Ex. What sort of grasses can be found there?



Conclusion

What did you just tell me about?

Sequentially recap what you've just written

Cover Sheet/ Intro

Project Background/ Regulatory Context

Environmental and Cultural History

Previous Research/ Research Methods

Results/ Synthesis

Recommendations

Well-structured paragraphs have similar characteristics:

- 4-7 sentences
- Each paragraph represents a single concept
- Introduction sentence supported by following sentences
- Concluding sentence ends thought concept

Logical reports also have similar characteristics:

- Introduction section tells the reader what to expect
- Other sections support what is announced in the introductory paragraph
- Concluding section recaps what was reported

The best essays follow this structure while also following the SHPO guidelines and your company's style guide:

- Proper report structure
- Proper citations
- Proper formatting
- Proper report sections
- Address the research design

Good archaeology technical report writing is designed to make it easy for the reader to understand your message.

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
